Just in case you miss their intent, one track is called Ludwig Van Ramone while another - Om Konz, impolitely blending deranged ska with overdriven electric piano punching out Bitches Brew dissonance - is dedicated on the sleeve to "Olivier Messiaen and the Yeah Yeah Yeahs". And if that sounds unbearably knowing, fear not. Last Chance Disco is tremendous fun, there's not a smug note on it. Leader Pete Wareham has fashioned catchy, visceral pieces, spitting and squawking them out on various saxophones with endearing energy while the superb band (Tom Cawley keys, Tom Herbert - bass, Sebastian Rochford - drums)

play with a startling garage attitude that doesn't quite belie their technical excellence. Makes The Bad Plus look like fakers.
